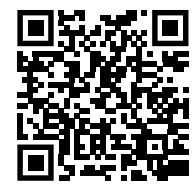
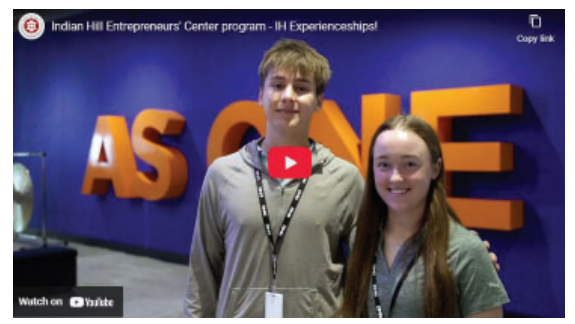

### INDIAN HILL SCHOOL DISTRICT EXPANDS REAL-WORLD LEARNING THROUGH IH EXPERIENCESHIPS

The Indian Hill School District is leading now through the IH Entrepreneurs' Center Experienceships program. The innovative model connects students with professional learning opportunities across a wide range of fields, and students didn't take the summer off from these unique opportunities. During June and July, 58 Indian Hill High School students participated in professional programs, job shadows, or internships with 36 unique partners - including nonprofits, higher education institutions, start-ups, and large businesses. The District also celebrates the 2024-2025 school year with 166 students actively enrolled in the IH Experienceships program, marking a record level of student engagement.

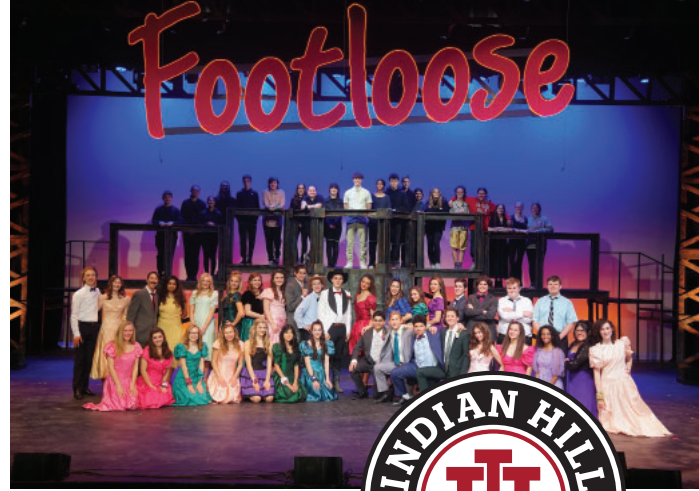


Ten IHHS Seniors are continuing in an area of the Arts or joining a branch of the Military.

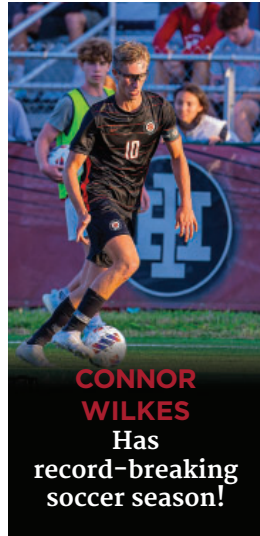

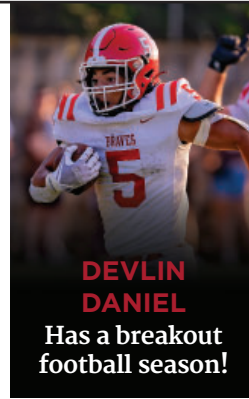

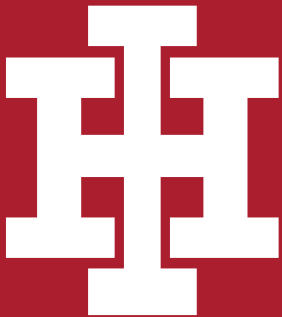
