The **Indian Hill Foundation** continues to fuel innovation, student leadership, and community support throughout the year. Below are just a few highlights of how your generosity is making an impact:

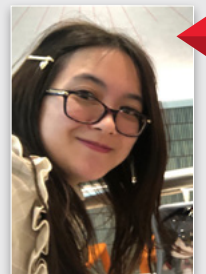
### By the Numbers: A Snapshot of Your Impact
